OCCUPATIONAL SAFETY AND HEALTH
POLICY STATEMENT

1. Safeguarding all personnel from injury is paramount to our mission and my top priority. The Safety Department, U.S. Naval Support Activity (NAVSUPACT), Naples, Italy, is fully committed to supporting the Navy Occupational Safety and Health (NAVOSH) Program to ensure a safe and healthy working environment in each workplace and to provide adequate support in hazardous environments. I consider no job or task so important that it cannot be accomplished in a safe manner.
2. NAVSUPACT Naples will seek to continually improve Occupational Safety and Health (OSH) and to reduce hazards that may cause injury to our personnel or damage property. Each and every member of my management team is responsible for the prevention of accidents and job-related illnesses.
3. Our OSH Program is designed to instill situational awareness within all personnel in order to prevent accidents and injuries in the workplace, at home, while traveling and during recreational or sports activities. All accidents or near-miss incidents must be reported to the OSH Office immediately. All command personnel are required to review NAVOSH standards, records of committee actions and recommendations and documentation of the Command OSH Program.
4. Military, civilian and Host National personnel shall not be subjected to restraint, coercion, interference, discrimination, or reprisal for exercising their rights under the NAVSUPACT Naples OSH Program.
5. This policy shall be posted on all official bulletin boards.
